The relevant function is itemstats_parse.

I'm not sure I understand what you need, as no version of itemstats is going to contain any reference to an unrelated fireboard variable.

The directions assume you have a working itemstats. All of the versions include a parse function.

Hello all. First off, thanks to everyone for their help in this thread.

I am running Joomla 1.0.12 and Fireboard 1.0.1, the latest Beta.

I tried adding the edits to the files mentioned earlier in my fireboard template directories, but there were some inconsistencies with the code mentioned and my own.

I have done the edits as noted following context as opposed to the actual content (read: I just added the edits anyways even though this was a mismatch) but it was to no avail. I assume the edits are written for another previous version of fireboard.

I installed my Fireboard this morning and used a conversion script to import my PhpBB2 database. Otherwise everything is vanilla.

I also tried to use PU Mambot by simply Installing it, removing my existing Itemstats folder from root, and removed the edits I originally did when installing Itemstats 1.5.5 in order to avoid any conflicts, not knowing exactly how the mambot functioned.
